Bosenberg offers individual and group motorcycle rentals through participating dealers with Aprilia, BMW, Ducati, Harley-David., Honda, Kawasaki, KTM, Triumph, Yamaha at gateways:

- Frankfurt/Main, Germany (BMW, Ducati, Honda, H.-D., Kawasaki, Triumph, Yamaha)
- Munich, Germany (BMW and Honda)
 - Berlin, Germany (BMW)
- Milan, Italy (BMW and Ducati)
- Bern, Switzerland (Aprilia, BMW, Ducati, Honda)
- Zurich, Switzerland (BMW, KTM, Triumph and Yamaha)

Ride the motorcycle at home or the model you have always dreamed about. It's your choice, not ours. Fly-in, ride and fly-out on your own schedule. We recommend to reserve your model first, then at your leisure to make air flight arrangements. Pick your favorite mount from over 50 European models. Tour, sport, sport-tour, cruiser, dual-sport and exotic mounts are featured. Choose from 650–1800cc and 46–178 horsepower for suitable mounts for all riding styles and all rider sizes.

Bosenberg confirms motorcycles by make and model through the order of application and deposit received. Making a reservation 4–5 months in advance isn't too early to insure you have a particular model for the time frame you want. For the high demand periods of June through August, a second rental period and alternate model selection are recommended. Last minute reservations 1 to 2 months prior to arrival are possible, but may result in requested models already reserved by someone else.

Special discounts

- Bring a riding friend: Reserve 2, 3 or 4 motorcycles at the same time and save 5% off the normal per bike rental price.
- Early bird booking: Reserve your motorcycle(s) at least 6 months prior to your rental start date and save 5% off the normal per bike rental price.
- Group: Reserve 5 or more motorcycles at the same time and save 10% off the normal per bike rental price (see para. 12 on p. 4).
- Repeat rider: If you joined us previously for a tour or rental, you save 5% off the normal per bike rental price.
- Long-term: Reserve your motorcycle(s) for 21 days or more and save 5% off the normal per bike rental price.

Combine these discounts and save even more. If in a group, different makes may require other rental centers and different locations at the same gateway. Each rider/driver receives a EuroRider travel information packet.

Two rental rates are available: All-Inclusive or Standard

For those planning to do more riding, the All-Inclusive rate offers unlimited mileage. For more sightseeing, the Standard rate offers 200 kilometers (124 miles) free per day.

All-Inclusive rental rates include:

- unlimited kilometers
- collision and comprehensive motorcycle insurance with a Loss Damage Waiver (LDW) deductible of € 1,500 (Germany/Italy) or CHF 2,000 (Switzerland) for standard/comfort class; € 2,000 (Germany/Italy) or CHF 2,500 (Switzerland) for sport/sport-tour class and € 2,500 (Germany/Italy) or CHF 3,000 (Switzerland) for top and super class models.
- The LDW deductible is also the safety and security deposit.
- third party liability insurance
- applicable country Value Added Tax (VAT)
- 2 hard side-cases, leather side bags, soft side bags and/or roll bags (depending upon model and dealer variation)
- EuroRider travel information packet

Standard rental rates include:

- All features listed above except for 200 kilometers (124 miles) free per day with extra kilometers over daily average charged in € 0.35–0.70 (Germany and Italy) or CHF 0.50–0.95 (Switzerland) per kilometer depending on model and gateway country.

Rental rate features are identical except for the kilometer calculation. There are no surprises, no unexpected extras, no preparation or cleaning fees, no extra sales or other taxes, no extra operator, no passenger or charges upon arrival. We guarantee rates in US Dollars. Models are current season.

Upon your application Bosenberg completes:

- Rental center coordination for a reservation based upon your model or class choices, rental time frame and gateway.
- Confirmation sent airmail (e-mail or fax) along with final invoice and EuroRider travel information packet.

Upon arrival at the rental center:

- English language rental agreement
- Free suitcase storage space
- Travel tips, information and route advice
- Hotel room reservation assistance for arrival and departure nights

Our **EuroRider travel packet** with 10 or more items is updated every season and contains:

- detailed instructions to reach a rental center using the public transportation network from your gateway airport (30–75 minutes or faster by taxi)
- International Driver's License (IDL) application (US residents only)

Rentals are available April through October. In Italy only, March through November. Rental center opening hours are Monday to Friday 10:00 AM to 12:30 PM and 2:00 to 6:00 PM; and Saturdays 10:00 AM to 1:00 PM. Sundays and holiday dates are always closed. In Switzerland only, Mondays are closed.

Holiday date closures for **2010**: April 2 and 5; May 1, 13 and 24; June 3; August 1 (Switzerland) and 15 (Italy and Switzerland), October 3 (Germany) and November 1 (Italy).

Holiday date closures in **2009**: April 10 and 13, May 1 and 21; June 1 and 11, August 1 (Switzerland) and 15 (Italy and Switzerland), October 3 (Germany) and November 1 (Italy).

Rentals can only be picked-up or returned during operating hours and can be signed for on the day of flight arrival. Special delivery and one-way rentals are not possible. Room reservations for your arrival and departure nights will be made upon arrival at your request by the rental center at a local nearby hotel which meets your comfort standard (or you can make your own reservations directly to a hotel of your choice).

Helmets are always available for rental. Depending upon model and rental center, and at an extra charge, it is possible to rent tank bags, GPS or top cases. Check-off requested equipment on your application. If you wish, bring along a tank bag if you know it will fit your designated model. Your dealer sells a wide variety of riding apparel with quality European name brand jackets, gloves, leathers, boots, rain suits and other clothing items.

Upon arrival at the rental center the full rental balance amount and the appropriate safety and security deposit is made by use of selected credit cards (American Express, MasterCard, VISA and JCB), traveler's checks or cash. When the undamaged motorcycle is returned, the deposit is fully refunded.

- Allocation of motorcycles and special model wishes are made according to the order of rental deposits received by Bosenberg. Please list alternate model choices on your rental application. There are a limited number of motorcycles for each model and class. Your make and model is confirmed with your rental reservation invoice. Models are current season renewed each year.
- Many models do not have windshields (dealer variation) unless originally installed by the manufacturer as a model standard feature. Some cruiser models are equipped with sissy bars for passenger back support.
- BMW models are equipped with BMW hard side-cases. Honda models are equipped with hard side-cases (Pan European, Gold Wing, etc.), leather side bags (Shadow, etc.) or soft side bags and/or roll bags (CBR 600 etc.) which varies from model to model per the manufacturer's originally outfitted OEM model features. Aprilia models, some Ducati and Triumph are equipped with soft side bags and/or roll bags. Sport models are with soft side bags and/or roll bags, but some equipped with hard side-cases (dealer variation). Cruisers are equipped with leather side-bags unless model is originally outfitted with hard side-cases (Road King, etc.). Most sport-tour models are outfitted with hard side-cases (Ducati ST 4S, Honda VFR, Yamaha TDM 900, etc.). Cruisers normally have sissy bar or passenger back rest.
- Bosenberg realizes riders come in different sizes and prefer different makes and models. As a guideline only, recommended size match between you and your mount:
500-700cc or sport class for solo riders
701-900cc for solo riders or with co-rider (combined weight < 300 lbs.)
over 900cc for solo riders or with co-rider (combined weight > 300 lbs.)
- Our models are manufactured for the European market and may differ slightly in specifications from your local home market. Models may also exist under another name in Europe or may not be offered in your local home market at all. If you need additional information to make an informed decision as to your model selections, please visit a local dealer.
 - Some dealers offer a Garmin Zumo 550, a TomTom Rider or a BMW OEM Navigator III GPS unit rental (based upon the Garmin Streetpilot 2720) with European maps, English menu and instructions for US\$ 19 per day. If available, the GPS unit rental is pre-wired and pre-installed on your bike. Rental also includes a 15 minute instruction on its use and numerous features upon arrival.

- 4 or 5 day rentals:** Within 30 days prior to a rental start date, it is sometimes possible to arrange 4 or 5 day rentals at all of our gateways. Rental applications can be sent to Bosenberg earlier, but any confirmations will be coordinated and reserved only 30 days prior to your actual requested rental start date. No EuroRider information packet is provided. A fax number is preferred (or e-mail address use is possible) for dealer pick-up instructions and invoice forwarding.

Rental rates

Models are in a distinct class category. Rental rates are priced per day in US dollars based on rental length, engine displacement and designated class. Examples: a Honda VFR 800 for 17 days is in the Sport-tour class 701-900cc displacement and rates are US \$155 (Standard) or US \$209 (All-Inclusive) per day; a Honda Shadow 750 for 12 days is in the Standard class 701-900cc displacement and rates are US \$145 (Standard) or US \$209 (All-Inclusive) per day.

1. RESERVATIONS and DEPOSITS:

Booking reservations can be by mail, fax or e-mail. A deposit of US \$500 per motorcycle by personal check, postal money order, credit card authorization or bank funds wire is required when submitting a rental application. Reservations are not confirmed until a deposit is received. Bank wire transfers should be arranged without any charges or fees for BME. The final rental balance payment (per our invoice to you) is due upon arrival at the rental center. A safety and security deposit of € 1,500 (Germany and Italy) or CHF 2,000 (Switzerland) for standard/comfort class; € 2,000 (Germany/Italy) or CHF 2,500 (Switzerland) for sport/sport-tour class or € 2,500 (Germany and Italy) or CHF 3,000 (Switzerland) for top/super class models is also deposited upon arrival at rental centers. When an undamaged motorcycle is returned, the safety and security deposit is fully refunded. Final on-site rental balance payments and safety and security deposit can be made with American Express, MasterCard, VISA and JCB credit cards.

2. CREDIT CARD AUTHORIZATION and USE:

If using a credit card authorization for the US \$500 rental deposit per motorcycle, your deposit is processed with the American Express, MasterCard, VISA and JCB credit card organizations in US \$. The final rental balance payment and security deposit at the gateway rental center are converted into € or CHF at the daily current US \$/€ or US\$/CHF fixing exchange rate and entered in € or CHF on the credit card voucher and rental agreement.

3. CANCELLATIONS, PENALTIES and REFUNDS:

If you wish to cancel a rental reservation up to 8 weeks prior to the rental pick-up date, a fee of US \$275, under 8 to 5 weeks, a fee of US \$375, under 5 to 2 weeks, a fee of US \$425, and under 2 weeks, the full deposit of US \$500 is assessed, because of nonrecoverable expenses and rental center deposits. A charge of US \$25 will be made for each requested change (model, rate or length) made after rental was confirmed and invoiced. This charge will be subtracted from the rental center deposit. If requesting a different make or model after your original rental application has been confirmed and invoiced, and this change requires a new dealer, the first reservation must be cancelled and a new rental application with deposit must be forwarded.

4. INSURANCE:

Motorcycles are insured for legal liability through the issuance of an International Motor Insurance Card providing third party liability insurance with a minimum coverage combined package limit of € or CHF 1,000,000 ceiling and for the motorcycle itself, a collision and comprehensive insurance with a Loss Damage Waiver (LDW) deductible of € 1,500 (Germany and Italy) or CHF 2,000 (Switzerland) for standard/comfort class; € 2,000 (Germany/Italy) or CHF 2,500 (Switzerland) sport/sport-tour class or € 2,500 (Germany/Italy) or CHF 3,000 (Switzerland) for top/super class models. The LDW deductible amount is also the model safety and security deposit. There are no other insurance coverages included or implied on rental use.

Whether a scheduled motorcycle tour, exclusive group tour, club trip, special custom tour, individual or group incentive travel tour; or individual and group motorcycle rentals, use our experience to your advantage for your ride of a life-time. Join Bosenberg for your ultimate ride in Germany, France, Switzerland, Italy, Liechtenstein, Austria, the Alps and beyond.

5. ADDITIONAL INSURANCE:

coverages are recommended for any extended travel and are your responsibility to obtain. These insurable areas include, but are not limited to: trip cancellation/interruption, personal accident, health, medical, hospitalization, disability, life, personal property, baggage, etc.

6. OPERATORS:

must be at least 18 years of age, possess a valid motorcycle driver's license and have at least 1 year or 5,000 miles of riding experience operating a high performance motorcycle. There are no extra operator charges. Only operators signing the rental agreement at the rental center are allowed to operate motorcycles. Riders/Drivers should not expect to learn how to ride a motorcycle while on a rental. Passengers should be at least 12 years of age. Personal riding gear should be brought along or can be purchased upon arrival. Helmet use is required by law in all European countries.

7. MOTORCYCLE USE:

is authorized in all countries of Europe and you are provided an International Motor Insurance Card. For use in eastern European countries only (i.e. Poland, Czech republic, Slovak Republic, Hungary, Bulgaria, Romania, Russia, Ukraine, Baltic states, former Yugoslavia, etc.) the rental center insurance company cannot insure loss or theft and you are fully and 100% liable for loss or theft of a bike in all eastern European countries. There is no Loss Damage Waiver (LDW) deductible for loss or theft for use in eastern European countries only and this will be noted on your rental agreement. Use is not authorized in Turkey and North Africa. Minimum rental period is 4 days. Rentals must be picked-up and returned during the rental center's normal opening hours. Special delivery and one-way rentals are not possible. Early return of motorcycle will not reduce rental price. Each calendar day is considered a rental day.

8. LIABILITY:

BME acts in the capacity of an agent and is only responsible for the conscientious handling and processing of a rental application. BME is not responsible or liable for any accidents and/or bodily injury or death resulting from the use of a rental and the customer will indemnify all such claims against BME. BME and represented rental centers reserve the right to change a model in same category displacement or upgrade a model (at no additional cost to you) due to unforeseen operational reasons.

9. RENTAL RATES:
